- Adhere to the Provincial Fire Regulations for all tents/canopies. Your tent must comply with Canadian Fire Standards with the fire retardant code **CAN/ULC-S109-M / NFPA701**. (Please note that U.S. fire-treated tents do not meet these standards). Your tent must have the original manufacturer's fire retardant tag attached to the tent. The Fire Marshal will **not** permit your site to open should your tent not meet these standards.

# Vendor Power Requirement Guide:

---

## Determining Power Requirements:

To determine your power requirements a simple calculation is needed:

$$\frac{\text{\# of Watts}}{\text{Voltage (typically 120v)}} = \text{Amperage draw}$$

For example:

$$\frac{1500 \text{ Watt Warmer}}{120V} = 12.5 \text{ Amps}$$

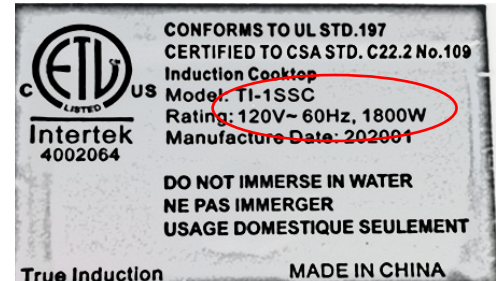

As a general rule, you do not want to exceed 80% of the total circuit capacity.

Based on this calculation and following the rule, if you had 5 x 1500-Watt warmers, you would require 5 x 15 Amp Circuits to ensure your power supply is constant without tripping the breaker.

Usually, you can find the wattage of your appliance located on a sticker (Figure 1.1)

## Special Connections:

A special connection is described as anything other than a normal 15 Amp outlet you would find in a typical home. Some examples of this would be a 220v 30 Amp 4-Pin Twist lock (Figure 1.2)
